<input type="checkbox"/>	Non-Chiari Syringomyelia - MRI cervical and thoracic spine within 6 months Tethered Cord - MRI lumbar spine within 6 months	Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) is a test that uses a magnetic field and pulses of radio wave energy to make a picture of the spine and its structures.	An MRI helps evaluate syringomyelia, tethered cord or other abnormalities.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Referral Request Form, and past 6 months of office visit notes from your Primary Care Physician (PCP), Neurologist, or Neurosurgeon.	The Referral Request Form is included with the initial packet you will receive, and is also available at auroramed.com/service/ccc . The referral provides Colorado Chiari Institute with your doctor's contact information.	The referring doctor will be the key contact during your care with Colorado Chiari Institute.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Laboratory Tests	Blood Tests <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hemoglobin A1c • C Reactive Protein (Cardiac) • Vitamin D level 	Lab tests screen for diabetes, chronic inflammation, and Vitamin D deficiency.
